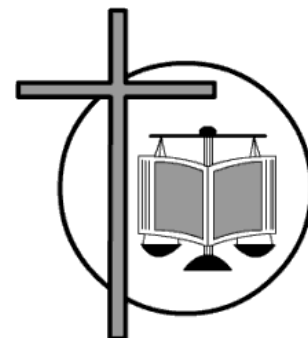

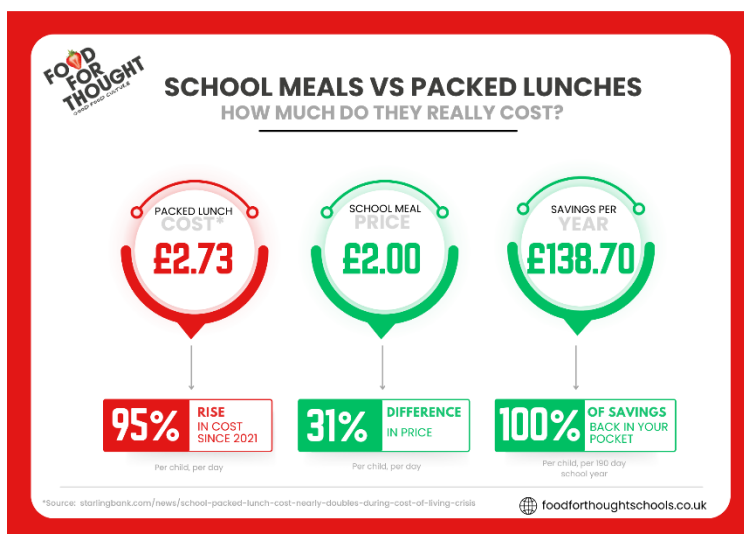
Parents/carers are invited to join us in Church on Thursday 28th March 9.30am for our Easter Assembly and singing celebration.
