Relationships and Sex Education (RSE)

On Tuesday 16th April, there was a meeting in school for Parents/Carers where we discussed our Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) curriculum, here at St Francis de Sales Infants. The RSE curriculum is a statutory requirement as part of The National Curriculum (2014) and Journey in Love from The Catholic Archdiocese. This national programme covers all age ranges, from Early Years up to secondary school. The early years and Key Stage 1 parts of the programme that we teach here in the Infant School, are wholly age-appropriate for our very young children, focussing on aspects of healthy relationships, including: friendships; families; growing and changing,; changing feelings; becoming more independent; keeping safe; developing self-esteem and confidence. Please be reassured that at no point do we teach 'sex' education or refer to the physical aspect of sexual intercourse in any way as it is not age appropriate.
